ANNEXURE-II

Instructions for Class Teachers for conducting minor tests 1 & 2 and evaluation of Tutorials/Home assignments

Note: Time permitted for conducting minor tests 1 & 2 shall be 1.30 hours each.

(A) Mode of conducting Minor tests 1 & 2:

Minor test 1 will be conducted after the completion of 48 teaching days (8 weeks).

Minor test 2 will be conducted after 90 teaching days (15 weeks)

Each test will be of 15 marks (15x2=30 marks).

Minor test 2 shall cover the second half of the course covered after Minor test 1.

Three types of questions will be set in Minor test 1 & 2:

1. Ten MCQ's of ½ mark each = 5 marks.
2. Two questions of short answer type in about 150 words each of 2.5 marks = 5 marks.
3. One question of about 900 words carrying 5 marks = 5 marks.

Total marks= 5+5+5=15 marks

(B) Distribution of marks for evaluation of Tutorial/Home assignments

1. 5 marks are assigned for quality of content and structure of assignment.
2. 5 marks are assigned for clarity of language of the script (English/Hindi) and its presentation in the classroom.
3. 5 marks are assigned for group discussion.

Total marks=5+5+5=15 marks

Distribution of marks for CCA in each course in each Semester:

1. Minor test 1=15 marks
2. Minor test 2= 15 marks
3. Tutorials/Home assignments=15 marks
4. Attendance=5 marks

Total marks=15+15+15+5=50 marks

ANNEXURE-III

Paper Setting Scheme for Semester Term End Examination

Maximum marks: 50

Minimum marks: 23

Maximum time: 3 hrs.

1. Instructions for Paper setters:

The question paper will consist of 5 sections:

A. Compulsory

B. Unit I

C. Unit II

D. Unit III

E. Unit IV

Section A: It will be compulsory consisting of 18 marks with 10 objective type questions which could be multiple choice questions, true/false, fill in the blanks etc. of 1 mark each and 4 short answer type questions of 2 marks each covering the entire syllabus.

Section B: There will be two questions of 8 marks each. These questions may contain sub parts and will be of long answer type. The student will attempt one out of the two questions.

Section C: There will be two questions of 8 marks each. These questions may contain sub parts and will be of long answer type. The student will attempt one out of the two questions.

Section D: There will be two questions of 8 marks each. These questions may contain sub parts and will be of long answer type. The student will attempt one out of the two questions.

Section E: There will be two questions of 8 marks each. These questions may contain sub parts and will be of long answer type. The student will attempt one out of the two questions.

Total marks: $18+8+8+8+8=50$.

2. Instructions for the students:

The students are required to attempt 5 questions in all. One compulsory question from section A and selecting one question from each of the sections B, C, D and E of the question paper.

Paper Setting Scheme for Semester Term End Practical Examination

Maximum marks: 50

Maximum time: 3 hrs.

Continuous Comprehensive Assessment: Based on Minor Tests (2), Class tests, Tutorials/Assignments, Quiz, Seminar and Attendance

Marks Attendance: 5% marks to be given as per the regulations

1. Instructions for Paper setters and candidates:

Laboratory examination will consist of two parts:

- (i) Performing a practical exercise assigned by the examiner
(50% of the total marks)
- (ii) Viva voce examination
(50% of the total marks)

Note: Viva voce examination will be related to the practical performed/seminar/ assignment done by the candidate related to the paper during the course of the semester.
